#### **Governor Update**

A second virtual Council of Governors meeting was held on 23 July where governors received the Trust's Annual Report and the Auditor's report on the accounts. It also received assurance regarding both the process and outcome of Non-Executive Director (NED) appraisals, and the Chair's appraisal. The Council were notified of the change in the Trust Chair and were introduced to Mike Potts who took over the role from 1 August 2020.

The Nomination and Remuneration Committee (NRC) met on 20 July and discussed the resumption of the Audit Chair appointment and the current NED vacancy. The Committee agreed that the appointment process for the former would be resumed and consideration will need to be given by the Board to the key requirements for the current vacancy.

A number of governors came to the end of their terms of office. Three governors had served a full three terms, or nine years with the Trust. They were Janet Sullivan who was an appointed governor for Sheffield Mencap, Sue Highton, a Staffside appointed governor and Jules Jones, a public governor in addition to Maggie Young, AHP Staff Governor who had served three years. Their contributions have been greatly valued.

#### **Governor Questions**

Three questions were received in June and all received responses. No questions were received in July.

#### **Governor Elections**

Elections resumed in June with a total of 12 seats available in 9 constituencies.

Three seats remain vacant: Public Rest of England, Young Service User/Carer and Clinical Support Staff. The outcome of the service user governor election will be published on 28 August 2020.

### Membership

Membership stands at 11609 at the end of July 2020. No membership events have taken place in line with advice from NHS England. However, Involve magazine was published and sent to all members in July providing information about the governor elections as well as formally introducing the Chief Executive and providing more information about the Trust's journey back to good. As a result of its publication, the Trust has been able to undertake a data cleanse with almost 400 members being removed. This number is likely to continue to grow over the next month.
