2. Summary

Providers of NHS healthcare are required to publish a quality account each year. NHS Improvement published the quality account requirements which stipulates what trusts have to include in their accounts in February 2020. Due to the Covid-19 global pandemic, the timescales to produce Quality Accounts were revised and trusts are only required to publish their accounts electronically on their profile on the NHS website by 15 December 2020.

The Quality Assurance Committee received a draft quality account at their October meeting, with an updated draft version received at their November meeting. External stakeholder consultation took place, with feedback requested by 20 November 2020. This was provided verbally into the Quality Assurance Committee and has been included in this final version for approval by the Board of Directors
