Summary of key points in report

This report provides the Council of Governors with an update on the outcome of the recent by-election for vacant seats. It also provides an update on additional representatives nominated for vacant seats held by Sheffield Council and outlines details of Governors who have stepped down since the last meeting and outlines current vacancies. These will be managed through the next election process in the summer of 2022.

The term of office for Governors is three years, with up to three consecutive terms being allowable after which governors must stand down. Each year elections take place to appoint to existing vacancies or to seats where the term of office has come to an end.

Following the elections held in the spring of 2022 vacancies remained on the Council of Governors in the staff and carer categories and for Sheffield North East.

Following advice received the Council of Governors agreed to hold a by – election in October/November 2022.

Section 2 of the report outlines the outcome of the elections and section 3 outlines other Governor changes including nominations received from Sheffield Council for their vacant nominated seats and detail on Governors who have stepped down or who are due to leave in the coming weeks.

All successfully appointed Governors will need to complete Fit and Proper Person's test, DBS and Declarations of Interest before they are finally confirmed in post the process for which is underway and expected to complete before February.

An induction workshop is planned for February 2023 for new and current governors.

Governor Elections Update

Section 1: Analysis and supporting detail

Background

- 1.1 The term of office for Governors is three years, with up to three consecutive terms being allowable after which governors must stand down. Each year elections take place to appoint to existing vacancies or to seats where the terms of office has come to an end.
- 1.2 A by-election was held in October/ November 2022 for vacant seats in place following the June 2022 election process.
- 1.3 Awareness raising took place with support from our Communications team with via the website, staff intranet (Jarvis), Twitter and Instagram. Governors and Board members were asked to raise awareness through their own networks, In addition, staff and carer network groups were contacted and asked for support in raising awareness of the staff and care vacancies.
- 1.4 The timetable for the election process is outlined below:

Governor Elections Autumn 2022 results

- 2.1 Nominations were received in line with the plan. The seats which remain unelected are as follows:
 - Public Northeast one nomination was received but this was withdrawn by the deadline as the individual joined the Trust as a staff member and therefore became ineligible.
 - Medical and Clinical no nominations were received
 - Psychology no nominations were received
 - Social Worker no nominations were received

2.2 All other seats were elected unopposed and the results were published by UK engage on the 14 November 2022. Confirmation is subject to successful completion of the Fit and Proper Persons test, DBS and Declarations of Interest. Declarations of Interest and Code of Conduct forms have been issued for completion. DBS checks will be undertaken by SHSC HR and requests are in process.

- 3.1 All successfully appointed Governors will need to complete Fit and Proper Person's test, DBS and Declarations of Interest before they are finally confirmed in post process underway.
- 3.2 An induction workshop for new governors is planned for 2 February 2023.
